New Business

1. Clean Boats Clean Waters Grant – Don Schroeder said HLA applied for and was awarded a Clean Boats Clean Waters grant worth up to \$4,000. Our commitment is to staff the boat ramp for 200 hours educating users on aquatic invasive species and how to prevent their spread. 2. DNR Walleye Restocking – Glenn Doering described the introduction this month of 18,000 walleye fingerlings into our lake. This may be the first stocking in 50 years.
3. Water Quality Report – Tim Nickels monitors the lake and reports test results to the DNR. The lake level is up 2.8", as of July 2, over last year which was very dry. 4. Curly Leaf Pondweed – John Grimmer witnessed the hand pulling of the aquatic invasive Curly Leaf Pondweed (CLP) by interns from the North Lakeland Discovery Center (NLDC). While NLDC is a valuable resource, and the half day effort is important, subsequent monitoring suggests that a more work needs to be done to stay ahead of CLP in the future.
5. HLA Officers – Dan Perkins mentioned that all of the officer's two-year terms are up and is looking for volunteers to take board positions.
